QUESTION:

I often watch YouTube videos to learn how to do things, including things for work.
But some videos are just too slow, and I want to them to speed up most of the time, but go back to normal speed on parts I want to focus on.

Can I easily manipulate the speed of a YouTube video as it plays?

ANSWER:

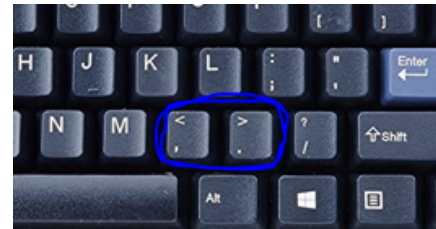
Yes.

As you are playing the video:

- [Shift] plus the period will speed it up.
- [Shift] plus the comma will slow it up.

In other words

- > to go faster
- < to go slower
