SITUATION/NEED:

When I'm at home and I remote into my Medical Towers computer, there is an informational banner at the top, telling me the name (IP address) of the computer I am remoted into. That's nice, but occasionally it gets "in my way"

BACKGROUND:

RDC stands for Remote Desktop Connection.

Sometimes you'll hear the term "when you RDC".

That means the same as:

- "when you remote into" or
- "when you connect remotely to" your Medical Towers Computer

SOLUTION:



Yes, you can literally move it out of your way.

Just click and hold on it (in a blank spot) and then simply slide it left or right.
