

A Guide to Birmingham Healthcare Resources

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Below is a list of major clinics in Birmingham. Several of these clinics require the patient to fill out a form and mail it in. We have printed several copies of the forms, so just ask the clinic director for a copy of the form as needed. Also be sure to notify the clinic leader if a referral is needed so that they can include it in the clinic report.

Resource	What is it?	What needs to be done?
Cooper Green	See separate handout.	Give patient a copy of the Cooper Green Enrollment handout.
UAB Financial Assistance	Specialty care for uninsured patients who are NOT Jefferson County residents.	Give the patient an application to fill out. They will need to mail it to the address provided in the application.
Project Access	Specialty care for uninsured patients.	Give the patient an application to fill out. They will need to mail it to the address provided in the application.
Cahaba Valley Health Screenings	Cahaba Valley hosts several health screenings at various locations for dental and vision problems.	Give your patient a list of upcoming screenings and let your clinic leader know which one(s) they can attend.
PATH Clinic	This is a diabetes clinic run by nursing students. They provide total diabetes care for patients with an A1c greater than 9.	Let the clinic leader know and make sure we have the patient's accurate contact information.
1917 Clinic	This is a clinic for patients with HIV/AIDS or those in need of testing.	Let the clinic leader know.
Jefferson County Health Department	Immunizations, vaccines, STD testing, etc. Most services require a copay.	Give the patient the contact information for the health department (205-933-9110) and explain that they may have to pay for services.
