1. **Cover Page:** Please submit a cover page with the following information for each of the authors. If multi-authored, indicate the primary presenter. The cover page does not count towards the 350 word limit.

 - b. School and Department
 - c. Division (if applicable)
 - d. Academic Rank

 2. **Structured Abstract Options:** There are three presentation categories. Please see below for the submission criteria. Select the most appropriate category and structure your abstract accordingly. Regardless of track selected, there is a strict 350-word limit. One table or figure is also allowed and should include a heading.

 - Background
 - Hypotheses/Aim
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusion
 - b. [For Innovation Submission](#) (a cool idea, new curriculum, or unique way of teaching)

 - Evaluation
 - Lessons Learned
 - c. [For Clinical Vignettes:](#) (interesting cases that highlight an important educational tool, such as a risk calculator, etc.)
 - Title
 - Introduction
 - Case Description
 - Important educational tool (i.e. highlight use of a risk calculator, unique mnemonic, etc., that is helpful in diagnosis, treatment, etc.)
