#### **Local Presentations:**

- For presentations at UAB, you are allowed two hours prior to the presentation and 1 hour following the presentation.
- For presentations within three hours driving time from Birmingham you are allow the full day of the presentation. (Example: Nashville, Atlanta, Montgomery etc.)

### Away Presentations:

- For presentations taking place before 12pm CST you are excused starting 12pm on the previous day and for the whole day of the presentation.
- For presentations taking place after 12pm CST you are excused for the whole day of the presentation and until 12pm the following day.

#### **International Presentations:**
