- Training program open to undergraduate students attending Morehouse College (MC),
 Spelman College (SC), Tuskegee University (TU), and UAB with aspirations of pursuing a career in cancer research and cancer related health professions.
- Program Dates: Monday, June 3 Friday, July 26, 2024 (eight weeks)
- Opportunity to work with cancer researchers and scientists
- Introduction to cancer research guided by faculty mentors
- Develop a comprehensive career plan to achieve goals
- Classes in Career Roadmaps, Scientific Writing, and Cultural Competency
- MCAT and GRE workshops
- Trainees will be paid a stipend of \$1,400 per month (\$2,800/summer)
- Housing at Morehouse School of Medicine may be available for Morehouse College & Spelman College trainees.*
- Housing at UAB may be available for Tuskegee students only (not available to UAB students).*
