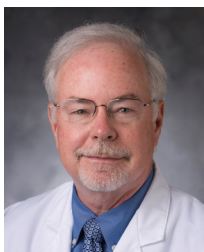
**RICHARD E. BLACKWELL,

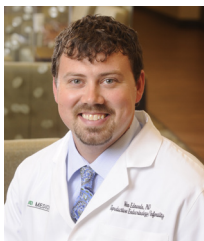

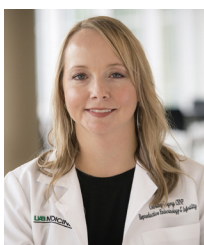
