



We provide extensive clinical services and teaching opportunities while maintaining robust research programs. Currently, the department is ranked #11 in the nation for extramural research funding with faculty recognized as leader for excellence in pathology research, training, and clinical services.

We're proud to offer flexible, individually-tailored programs in Anatomic Pathology, Clinical Pathology, or combined AP/CP leading to board eligibility with a 98% board pass rate. 87 full time faculty members with a broad range of clinical, research, teaching and administrative expertise with 38 faculty holding secondary positions in Pathology create a diverse medical education environment.



Benefits
