

Guidelines for CTA Interpretation

Weekdays (non-holiday)

Inpatient CTAs

0730-1700

Body reads all CTAs, including runoffs for PVD, surgical planning, etc (NOT TAVR).

1700-0730

ED Radiology will read all emergent CTAs, including runoffs for PVD, surgical planning, etc.

ED CTAs:

0730-1200

IR will read non-traumatic CTAs (i.e. PVD, surgical planning, etc.)

The CT tech will page the fellow or attending once the study is marked complete.

ED Radiology will read all trauma related CTAs

1200-0730

ED will read all CTAs, including runoffs for PVD, surgical planning, etc.

TAVR:

All TAVR CTAs will be read by IR (inpatient and outpatient).

Weekends/Holidays

Inpatient CTAs

0730-1700:

Body on-call reads all CTAs, including runoffs for PVD, surgical planning, etc (NOT TAVR).

1700-0730

ED Radiology will read all emergent CTAs, including runoffs for PVD, surgical planning, etc.

ED CTAs:

0730-1200

Body on-call attending/residents will read all traumatic and non-traumatic CTAs

1200-0730

ED will read all traumatic CTAs, including runoffs for PVD, surgical planning, etc.

TAVR:

All TAVR CTAs will be read by IR on Monday when 3Ds are complete (inpatient and outpatient).
