About the PRSTP Program:

- Training program open for **undergraduate students** from historically black colleges/universities (HBCU), minority-serving institutions (MSIs), and UAB.
- Must have a scientific discipline and interest in cancer medicine, basic cancer research, health disparities, or similar
- Eight-week training program
- Weekly noon conferences with UAB cancer researchers (includes lunch)
- Opportunity to work with UAB cancer researchers and scientists on existing R01 research projects
- Students will receive a stipend for at least 30 hours a week
- Students can add this NCI-funded program experience to their CVs
- Abstract/Poster presentation at Tuskegee University during the Cancer Research Symposium July 22nd, 23rd, 2020 (hotel and travel paid).
