- Doctoral student in good standing at UAB
- Be midway through 1st year in a doctoral program and prepared to enter 2nd year of training in August
- <u>U.S. citizen or permanent resident</u>
- Express a long-term plan and expectation to work as an independent investigator in obesity-research
