Violence against Women during COVID-19

This four-module course, available in both English and Spanish, is designed to equip primary healthcare professionals to care for women suffering from domestic violence during the COVID-19 pandemic. Participants are introduced to interprofessional principles of trauma-informed care for victims of domestic violence and/or sex trafficking, and to their unique healthcare needs, including risk for myocardial infarction.
