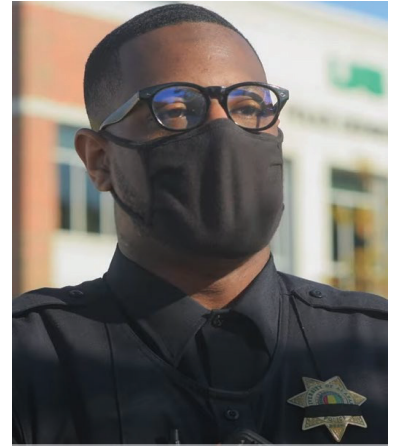

face covering



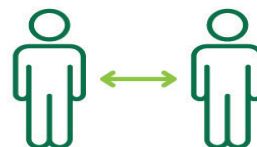

## Tips to stay safe with online purchasing:

- Meet in safe public location for the transaction
- When possible, bring a friend to accompany you during the transaction
- Beware of vague or “too good to be true” offers
- If you are given a cashier’s check or money order call the bank that issued it to verify the validity
- Call your local police if you feel unsafe or see something suspicious
- Complete the transaction during daylight hours
- Trust your instincts; if it sounds like a scam, it probably is



## Four easy steps to pedestrian safety on campus

### Don’t jaywalk, use the crosswalk instead.

In Birmingham, it’s against city ordinance to cross a street anywhere but a crosswalk.

### Keep your head up, your phone down.

If you’re on your phone, text-messaging, browsing the Internet or listening to music, you are increasing your risks of being hit by a car.

### Stick to the sidewalk.

If a sidewalk isn’t available, walk on the far side of the road facing traffic to help increase your visibility to drivers.

### Be visible

At nighttime, wear reflective or light-colored clothing to alert drivers and stay in well-lit areas.
