The University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB) is submitting the enclosed fringe benefit rate proposals, for your approval, for use in fiscal year 2023-2024. These rates would be a revision to the approved composite fringe benefit rate already in effect for fiscal year 2022-2023. The rates are based on actual activity from the fiscal year ended September 30, 2022, with projections for fiscal year 2022-2023 and fiscal year 2023-2024. These rates are to be effective October 1, 2023.

The following rates are proposed for UAB Campus:

Faculty 28.5 %
Part-time, Temporary & Irregular 08.0 %
Post Docs 21.2 %
All others 35.2 %

Students 00.0 % (No rate requested)

The following rates are proposed for UAB Hospital:

Faculty 00.0 % (Included in UAB Campus)

Part-time, Temporary & Irregular 18.1 %
Residents, Fellows & Post Docs 17.6 %
All others 31.9 %

Students 00.0 % (No rate requested)

The proposal includes descriptions of the employee groupings, fringe benefits and fringe benefit policies; the method of accumulating and allocating costs to calculate the rates; assumptions made in cost projections for fiscal years 2023 and 2024; the anticipated changes to fringe benefit policies; and a reconciliation of the proposal to the audited financial statements.
