

Clear expectations of the relationship

No surprises or hurt feelings

Fair for all students

Models Professionalism

## Setting Boundaries

#### When to Discuss:

- Orientation
- Throughout the rotation
- Reiterate if overstepping occurs

#### **UAB Specific Boundaries:**

- No exchange of money
  - Babysitting, dog walking, buying lunch
- No one on one out of office socializing
- No discussing other students
