Tangled Up In Blue: Depression, Distress and Diabetes

This talk will provide an overview of the latest research developments on understanding the links among diabetes, depression and diabetes-related distress. Evidence linking depression and distress to problems with diabetes self-management and poor diabetes treatment outcomes will be reviewed and potential mechanisms explaining these associations will be considered.

Intervention trials and models for treatment will also be reviewed and recommendations for clinical practice and future research will be provided.
