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Closing the Gap: Diabetes Prevention and Treatment – Take 2

Presentation description: Both the clinical burden and the cost burden of type 2 diabetes in the United States are enormous. Understanding their drivers can help inform interventions. Although targeted interventions for diabetes prevention and better application of proven-effective clinical interventions to treat diabetes can begin to address the problems, policies and practices are needed to address social determinants of health and health system redesign. I will discuss the effectiveness and limitations of targeted interventions for diabetes prevention and clinical interventions for diabetes treatment. I will highlight the need to address type 2 diabetes within its socioecological context and to address health system redesign.
