Tips to Prevent Cheating on Exams

These may not guarantee that students won't cheat, but they're a step in the right direction.

1. Scramble questions. If you're never done this, check out our previous Tip [here](#).
2. Scramble answers. This option is found under the quiz details in Canvas.
Note: If you do scramble the answers, you cannot use an "all of the above" or "none of the above" response. Instead, consider using a multiple response. (If you send your tests to the ISS team to input, this requires specific formatting. Check back next week for info on formatting tests.)
3. Use Respondus LockDown Browser AND a password. Be sure to follow these [new instructions](#) for LockDown Browser.
4. For online students, take advantage of [ProctorU](#) services. ProctorU provides free monitoring for 2 tests per semester. There is a fee for any additional tests (and a fee for **any** non-Q section courses).
