Using Images and Video in Canvas Courses

IMAGES: It's always best to assume that images on Google, Flickr, and other sites are copyright protected. Consult the [Fair Use 4 Element Test](#) in order to determine whether you can use an image without permission. Other alternatives for securing images include using the [SHP Getty Images account](#) or [Creative Commons](#), which allows users to use images with certain restrictions.

VIDEO: Instructors and students at non-profit educational institutions are allowed to show films in a classroom or other similar places devoted to instruction in the course of face-to-face teaching activities. That is, if the film ties into some educational purpose for your course, you may show it to your students.
