



Kaltura Transcript Widget

Making online course material accessible is an important principle of Universal Design. One way to do this is by providing captions or transcripts for all video or audio elements embedded in a course. This is easier than ever with Kaltura's machine captioning and caption editing features. Kaltura has also just added a new Transcript Widget that allows end users to:

- Follow along the video with a scrolling transcript (current spoken word highlighted)
- Search the transcript by keywords and jump to that part of the video
- Download and print the transcript
- Toggle the visibility of the transcript

To embed a video with this new widget, Edit your page and click on Embed Kaltura Media. Then, rather than clicking the Embed button, click on the gear to access the Embed Settings:
