- Developing tailored programs may meet the needs of marginalized populations, such as the Transgender community more effectively.

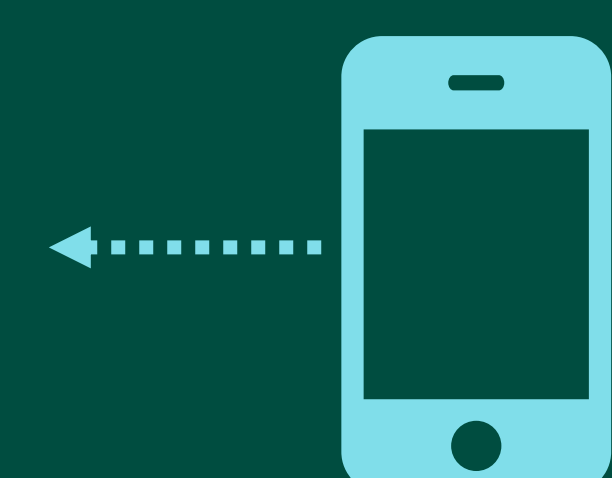
## OTHER COMMUNITY PARTNERS INVOLVED

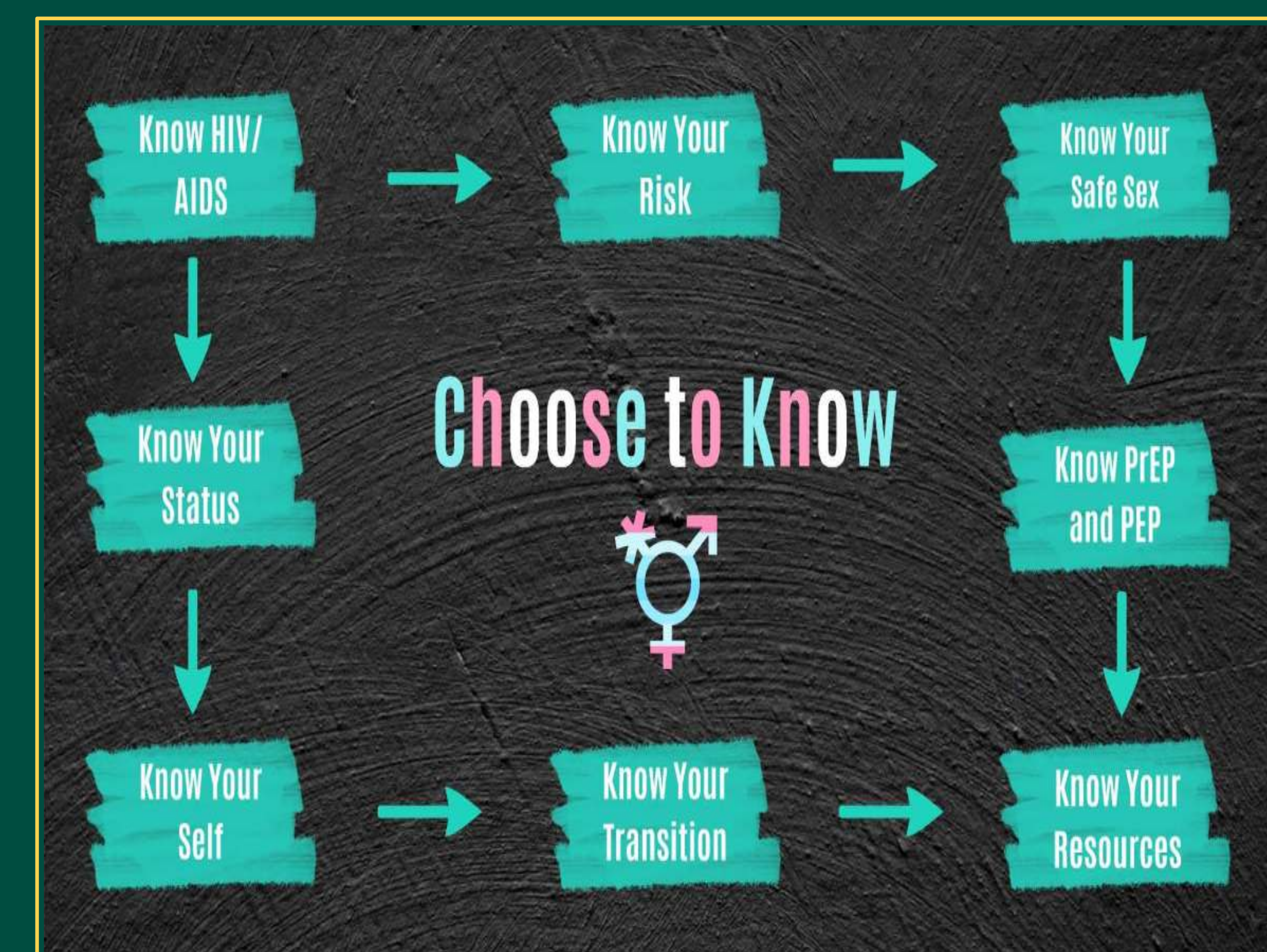
