Activity Enriches the Educational Purposes of UAB	The activity adds little value to the educational purposes of UAB.	This activity adds value to the educational purpose of UAB, though it is not articulated clearly.	Clearly articulated value to the educational purposes of UAB. Provides examples of connection to the educational mission, and how this initiative will enrich that mission.
Activity is Effortful and Time-Intensive	Insignificant amount of time spent on task – very little effort and time for student engagement.	Some time and effort is needed for a student to complete initiative, but it is not defined clearly.	Clear expectations exist in terms of the time a student will engage and the effort needed to complete the initiative. The time and effort are required for the impact of the initiative.
