- At least twice weekly, specific to the section/professor

? *What are the qualifications for* SI Leaders?

- Students who have completed the course at UAB with at least a B+ and have at least 3.00 GPA.
- Complete 2-3 hour training workshop.
All training is focused on metacognitive learning strategies and tools, and using Bloom's Taxonomy to help students work their way into higher-level critical thinking skills.
- You can expect your SIL to be well-versed in the subject material and study strategies.
