





Hours by Month








Participant Classification



Participant Ethnicity









Engagement & Learning In AY24, Student Involvement & Leadership will increase the number of undergraduate students who participate in SIL sponsored activities by 13% through the evaluation of programmatic format, promotion, and means of access.

Action Step

Increase fraternity and sorority community membership by a minimum of 3% through chapter growth and council expansion.

Progress:

For the first time since Fall 2020, the membership for the fraternity and sorority community exceeds 1,000 members for a total fall-to-fall membership increase of 10.3%.

Increase senior student participation in Homecoming activities by modifying promotional strategies and program format to align with the Final Year Experience initiative.

Progress:

A total of 4 student events were hosted as a part of the Homecoming Spirit Week with a total of 1,650 participants. 15.21% of those participants were classified as seniors which is a 4% increase from fall 2022.

Community Engagement In AY24, Student Involvement & Leadership will implement a formal model for critical reflection for all events that provide space for students to engage with the Birmingham community, strengthening their ability to make the community a priority in their values and actions.

Action Step

Incorporate intentional education and reflection into Rise Against Hunger service initiatives, resulting in heightened interest in future community engagement experiences and opportunities to eradicate hunger.

Progress:

Hosted a total of 258 volunteers through Rise Against Hunger on Tuesday, November 12th. Students completed 351 service hours while packaging 20,160 meals for Rise Against Hunger. See signature service highlight for demographic information and qualitative data.
