- *Virtual-Active*: Activities where a participant has to log on to a designated online platform at a specified date and time in order to attend/participate in the program.
- *Virtual-Passive*: Activities where a participant can view the program or participate in the program at a time of their choosing. Virtual-passive programs are typically recorded using technology and then published to an online platform (YouTube, Instagram, website, etc.).
- *In-Person*: Activities where a participant must physically attend the program/event in order to participate. An in-person program takes place on a specified day/dates at a designated location.


