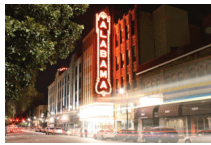
UAB Medicine provides care to people in every county in Alabama.

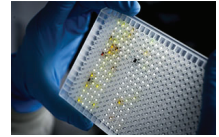

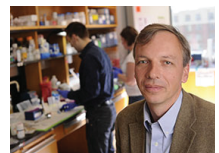
