

Our office has been hard at work on a variety of projects meant to reinforce our mission to enrich the student experience, inside and out.

From our Freshman Forum and its directors

Madhanagopal, we will be starting a
concentrated effort to reach out to campus
partners on initiatives identified as important
to the freshman class. They have also built a
mentorship program connecting our FF

When it comes to what the Office of the President has drastically changed, we chose our Election Commission and confirmed during the Fall semester, allowing them to formulate an Election Manual to guide future Commissions through the election process. Led by Election Manager Sarah Wilson, they have been hard at work preparing for and planning for this upcoming semester. In the same vein of growth, we have started a Lobby Board, led by Director of Political Advocacy Wajiha Mekki. After selecting her board and training them, they worked with the Southern Poverty Law Center this past semester in a Phone Banking effort that resulted in over 40 volunteers making 6000+ phone calls and sending 200,000+ texts to ensure that our greater Alabama community was registered to vote.

Our efforts in ensuring that we build a mutually beneficial relationship with the community through service and entertainment are led by the selection of Directors of External Affairs John Goodman and Sathvik Bodepudi, Together, we have been working on building a relationship with the Mayor's office, setting up a volunteer tracking page for USGA on BlazerPulse, and working with our community partner, Sienna Cafe, to support a Magic City Golf Classic. We also made efforts to connect Sienna Cafe to Sodexo with the hopes of a local cafe opening on campus.

My personal goal this semester was to have a study option open for students on the weekends, and our brand new Student Assembly Building is now open to all for studying and meetings on Saturdays and Sundays from 2-9. We held a finals cafe throughout finals week last semester, and stocked our free coffee and snack bar throughout that time.


