- be represented by the Student Advocate, and the USGA will be represented by theAttorney General; and

- 18 WHEREAS the appealing member, the Student Advocate, and the Attorney General,
- shall stand before the Justices of the Judicial Branch to appeal the issuance of ademerit; and

- 22 WHEREAS the appealing member will need a majority vote from the Justices of the 23 Judicial Branch; and

- WHEREAS the demerit policy made by any USGA entity should be approved by theUSGA Advisors; and

- 28 WHEREAS any contradictory language to the procedures in this Amendment in the
- 29 Code of Laws will be trumped by the passage of this Amendment; and

- WHEREAS the passage of this amendment will remove Section 301.5.8.3 in the Code of Laws which states "to remove a Senator from office a written excuse is not accepted"; and

- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the UAB USGA, representing the undergraduate student population, will establish this system in the UAB USGA Code of Laws and follow through with these procedures.
