Ctrl	v	Paste what you copied or cut
		(In case you're wondering why this is done with "v", it's simply because on your keyboard, the letters c, x and v are next to each other.)
Ctrl	Z	Undo what you just did
Ctri	У	Reverse your "Undo"
Ctrl	b	Make your text bold
Ctrl	i	Make your text italics
Ctrl	u	Underline
Ctrl	a	Select All (everything in current window)
Ctrl	Р	Print
Ctri		Move left or right an entire word at a time
