SOLUTION:

Open your settings menu -



then tap "general" then "keyboard" then "text replacement" menus Tap on the + in the top right corner

In the Phrase field, type in the entire phrase you'd like to create a shortcut for In the Shortcut field, type in the snippet you want to be replaced by the phrase Tap Save at the top right
