### SITUATION:

Moving windows around using only the keyboard. Sometimes it is difficult to do this with a mouse due to sensitivity. Good for organizing multiple windows or applications on one or more monitors.

### SOLUTION:

1. Hold down the windows key... which looks something like this 
2. Use the directional arrows to move the active window/application whichever direction you want.
