3 places you can scan to

SITUATION:

I want options when I scan to myself from the Kyoceras.

SOLUTION:

You have options when you scan to yourself on a Kyocera:

[Email]	This button sends it to your email address
[Scan Home]	 That button will put the scanned item into your H:Drive into a folder called "Scans". (If you don't already have a Scans folder, it's automatically created for you.) This is slightly more reliable than the Email option because it's a shorter path for the file to take, thus less chance for failure along the way. Also, size limitations aren't usually a problem with this, as they can be for Email.
Scan to Thumb Drive	 A 3rd option is that you can scan to a thumb drive. This is not a simple "press of a button" process, but it can be a good choice if you have a giant document or lots to scan and want to confirm success while still standing at the Kyocera. The steps for this aren't listed on the instructions taped to each Kyocera, but I (Lisa) have instructions for that that I can email you if ever needed.
