## 3 places you can scan to

### SITUATION:

I want options when I scan to myself from the Kyoceras.

### SOLUTION:

You have options when you scan to yourself on a Kyocera:

<b>[Email]</b>	This button sends it to your email address
<b>[Scan Home]</b>	<p>That button will put the scanned item into your H:Drive into a folder called "<b>Scans</b>".</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• (If you don't already have a <b>Scans</b> folder, it's automatically created for you.)</li> <li>• This is slightly more reliable than the Email option because it's a shorter path for the file to take, thus less chance for failure along the way.</li> <li>• Also, size limitations aren't usually a problem with this, as they can be for Email.</li> </ul>
<b>Scan to Thumb Drive</b>	<p>A 3<sup>rd</sup> option is that you can scan to a thumb drive.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This is not a simple "press of a button" process, but it can be a good choice if you have a giant document or lots to scan and want to confirm success while still standing at the Kyocera.</li> <li>• The steps for this aren't listed on the instructions taped to each Kyocera, but I (Lisa) have instructions for that that I can email you if ever needed.</li> </ul>
