I want an icon on my Windows desktop that is a shortcut to a particular website that I use a lot.

SOLUTION:

- 1. In Internet Explorer, open to that particular website (or any webpage within a website)
- 2. Right click in any blank space on the website
- 3. From the context menu which pops up, select Create shortcut.
- 4. Click [Yes]

That's it. That shortcut is now on your Desktop.

Tip: You can rename the shortcut to a name that makes more sense to you by right-clicking on it and choose [Rename]
