## How to "change" your @uab.edu email address (if you want to)

## **SITUATION:**

I really don't like my work email addresses.

It's hard to spell or doesn't seem professional enough, or just is not memorable enough.

For example: Now, my email is: <u>SillyAli@uab.edu</u> or <u>AHardTo-SpellLastName@uabmc.edu</u>

I'd rather it be <a href="UABAlice@uab.edu">UABAlice@uab.edu</a>

Can I do anything about it?

## **SOLUTION:**

Yes. You can create basically any "alias" you want for your @uab.edu email address. Think of it as an "Also Known As"

To do that, follow these steps:

- 1. <a href="http://www.uab.edu/directory/">http://www.uab.edu/directory/</a>
- 2. "Authenticate" with your BlazerID and password (if asked)
- 3. Click "Change Email Preferences" on the left side
- 4. Click "CLICK HERE to add or change mail-only aliases" link on that page
- 5. Type in the alias you want. In this example: UABAlice
- 6. Click "Submit".
- 7. Be sure to test it out to make sure all work as expected.

## Notes:

- Of course anything sent to you at @uab.edu, then automatically redirects to your actual @uabmc.edu email account.
- Obviously, if "UABAlice" (or whatever) is already taken, then you won't be able to have that one.
- In this example, <u>SillyAli@uab.edu</u> will still be a valid email address for you. <u>UABAlice@uab.edu</u> is just an <u>additional</u> one.
