Situation:

The small white mouse pointer is hard to see or find.

Solution:

Click the Start Button  then choose “Control Panel”. In the Upper Right Corner you will see “View by:” Click dropdown and choose “Large Icons.”

Click on “Mouse” → “Pointers” → “Scheme”

From drop down choose “Windows Black (Large) (system scheme)” or choose the one labeled “Windows Black (Extra Large) (system scheme).”

Click “Apply.”

Additionally, you can choose the tab at the top “Pointer Options” and at the bottom click on the check box next to “Show location of pointer when I press the CTRL key.”

This will draw circles around the mouse pointer when you press and release the “CTRL” key on the keyboard.
