SITUATION:

You're having a hard time seeing small text in your internet browser (such as Internet Explorer)



SOLUTION:

Experiment with your mouse wheel:

Hold the **Control** button down as you scroll with the mouse wheel.

Or....

- Control (or "Command" on Mac) plus "+" zooms in
- Control (or "Command" on Mac) plus "-" zooms out
- Control (or "Command" on Mac) plus "0" resets it to default
