SITUATION:

Sometimes I'll need to access my work email when I'm not at my desk at Medical Towers. For example, I might be at home or elsewhere, or using a computer that is not "mine" here in Medical Towers.

Can I do that, easily?


SOLUTION:

Yes, absolutely. Just use **webmail** -- which is located at <https://webmail.uabmc.edu/>

- Your **User name** = the part to the left of @ in your @uabmc.edu email address
- Your **Password** = your email password
 - Aka: your Outlook password, your HSIS password, your "One Password", your @uabmc password, your Citrix password
 - This is NOT the same as your DOPM (computer) password

- I want to connect to the newest General Office Server (i.e., "remote into Terminal Server", "T54")
