### BACKGROUND:

The term "Internet browser" (or simply "browser") just means the software on my computer (like Internet Explorer or Firefox) that lets me view a website.

## **QUESTION:**

Does it matter which browser I use?

Do different browsers display things differently, or have different problems?

(Asking because having trouble with IRAP and Oracle, depending on the browser I use.)

## ANSWER:

There are indeed pros and cons for each of these various browsers: Internet Explorer (IE), Firefox, Chrome.

Unfortunately, there are:

- some UAB things that won't work in Internet Explorer
- some UAB things that won't work in Chrome, and
- some UAB things that currently work in Firefox but soon won't work in Firefox
