
Every now and then, Word just does not do what I want it to do, or it does some weird formatting that I can't figure out why?

What is the first thing I can do to troubleshoot that?

ANSWER:

Turn on what I call the "Paragraph symbol", circled in red in the following screen shot. That will show you any hidden formatting symbols, and might help you delete something that is causing a problem.

(You can do something similar in Outlook too.)
