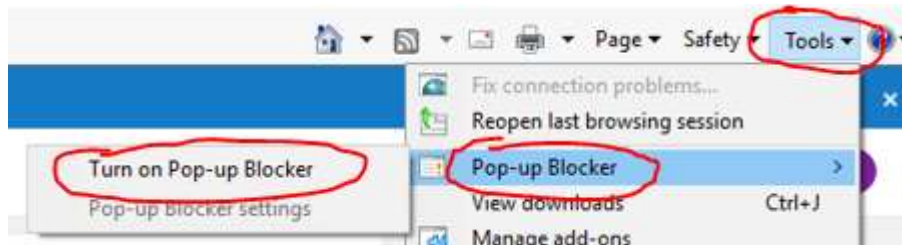

You can turn your "Pop-up blocker" on.
