You can turn your "Pop-up blocker" on. Here's how:

Turn on Pop-up Blocker	Pop-up Blocker	>
Pop-up Blocker settings	View downloads Manage add-ons	Ctrl+J

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Note: Occasionally, you might actually want Pop-ups; for example in Oracle. So if a website is not behaving like you think it should, look at the bottom of the screen; and if it say something like ...

... answer that appropriately.
