## SOLUTION:

We have tested and found http://whenisgood.net/ to be useful, and Laura Gallitz recommends it.

It's basic, graphical and very intuitive.
And it's free. No registration or anything is required.

Tips/review from Laura:
"When Is Good" is a helpful tool. It's really straightforward. You can pick dates and times and send it out for everyone else to pick their dates and times. You can select the duration of the meeting in the top left hand corner. It's a no-frills website, but it gets the job done. If you are coordinating with folks outside UAB, I would definitely emphasize that you need to check the "Use Time Zones" button in the bottom left-hand corner of the screen.
