Other possible options:

- files in "Microsoft Teams" -- good if sharing casually only with others in your Microsoft Team
- Joomla Use Joomla to put up on a public website, if you want to make the files public
- emailing as an attachment this is a "quick and dirty" solution, but it can be hard to keep up with "what is the most current version"
