SITUATION/QUESTION:

That little white mouse pointer is hard to find on multiple screens. Can I make it bigger and a different color?

SOLUTION/ANSWER:

The Great News is "YES".

1. Click the 'start button' – the one with 4 squares on it in lower left corner of screen
2. Select the 'gear' on the left side
3. Type MOUSE in the search bar at the top
4. Choose "MOUSE SETTINGS"
5. Choose "ADJUST MOUSE & CURSOR SIZE" under RELATED SETTINGS (on the right side)
6. Play with the options presented till you get something you like – Have fun!
